First-Plymouth Early Education Programs serve as research classrooms for the Dimensions Educational Research Foundation, an independent 501(c) 3 organization.

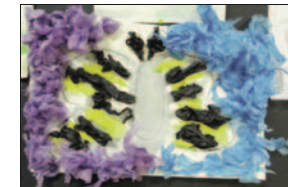
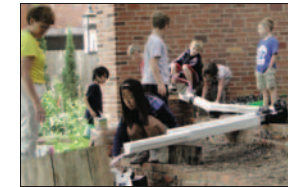

*The 2-5 Group may create their own activities and curriculum based on their interest.*

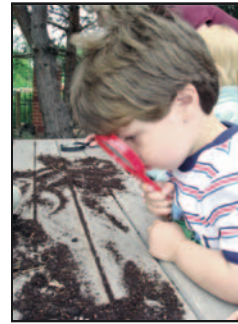


*Nature Explore research-based materials and ideas are woven into all activities, immersing children in hands-on observation and exploration.*
